







On 7 February 2022, Senators Antoine LEFEVRE, Anne Catherine LOISIER and Jean-Yves ROUX, in the name of the Senate's delegation for local authorities and decentralization, submitted their report on "*connected territories and protection of the population*".

THE ROLE OF VIGILANT NEIGHBOURS

No sheriffs, no militia and no defamation here!

A / Vigilant neighbours keep an eye on their neighbourhood, but they do not do surveillance. They do not replace the police.

B / They always alert the police (17) in case of an obvious offence or immediate danger

C / They are connected to each other within "communities", each of which corresponds to a sector of the municipality (neighbourhood, street, residence, village, etc.)

3 IDENTIFIED RISKS OF DERIVATIVES
